Introduction

Indian Statistical Institute, SQC & OR Unit, Hyderabad along with Sikkim Manipal Institute of Medical Sciences, Sikkim is organizing a North-East workshop on "Data Analytics for Medical and Healthcare Professionals" with a focus on Statistically Conducting and Defending Medical Studies. Data driven decision making is key to success in real-life and more so in healthcare where it is dangerous to act based on views, opinions and hunches. The beauty of data based approaches is that it not only helps in getting credible and reliable results but also always has the ability of providing some new insight about the phenomenon under study which per say was not known earlier. Data and statistical methods which can extract meaningful known as well as unknow information from the data are more and more an integral part of the studies conducted by Medical and healthcare professionals. Present day medical research is focusing on seeking long pending solutions to chronic and complex diseases. These studies especially longitudinal studies are generating large volumes of data (Bigdata). There is an urgent need for the medical professionals to understand the methods associated with analysing, inferring and defending the studies involving bigdata and related statistical methods.
